



Long Road Tour this weekend

The Long Road Tour rolls in to Port Augusta this weekend, featuring top Australian artists the Screaming Jets and The Butterfly Effect.

In a huge coup for people of country areas and the outback, Channel Events brings these two diverse Australian headline acts into one amazing musical synergy.

Concert-goers in Port Augusta will be the first to experience tracks from both bands forthcoming albums, an honour usually reserved for capital cities.

Joining these two bands is the father and son combination of Kevin and Lucias Borich and long time friend, and bass maestro, Harry Thunder Thumb Brus.

Stir in Sydney's hard core rock outfit Lawless Breed, who leave for Berlin on Sunday, plus

a fifth act from the region and that's one serious amount of rock in some seriously hard places.

The Butterfly Effect album Imago reached number two on the Aria charts and has achieved gold status, and the excitement preceding the release of Final Conversations of Kings promises to surpass their sophomore album.

The Screaming Jets have three platinum and three gold albums, and a host of platinum and gold singles to their name.

They are currently finalising their seventh studio album, and first with US producer Stevie Salas, who recently produced Daughtry's debut album.

The Jets have also secured Guns and Roses drummer Matt Sorum as a guest on the

album.

With the Borichs and Lawless Breed, this is a show not to be missed.
